Notes

1. The definition of a Parishioner is a person who has lived until their death¹ or at the time of death owned a property within the Local Authority Boundary of the Parish of Godstone. A 7-year Parishioner is a person who at some time during their life lived for a period of 7 years within the Parish of Godstone.

2. The Parish Council has agreed that there would be no charge for the burial of the stillborn and children under the age of 12. The normal purchase price of the grave space would remain the same, but the interment fee would be waived.

3. The fees exclude the digging of the grave plot. Please contact Mr M Tamplin via the Clerk to the Parish Council
