- The definition of a Parishioner is a person who has lived until their death¹ or at the time of death owned a property within the Local Authority Boundary of the Parish of Godstone. A 7-year Parishioner is a person who at some time during their life lived for a period of 7 years within the Parish of Godstone.
- The Parish Council has agreed that there should be no charge for the burial of a stillborn baby and children under the age of 12. The normal purchase price of the grave space would remain the same, but the interment fee would be waived.
- The fees exclude the digging of the grave plot. Please contact Mr M Tamplin via the Clerk to the Parish Council
